

Paper Pulp 1984 -1990

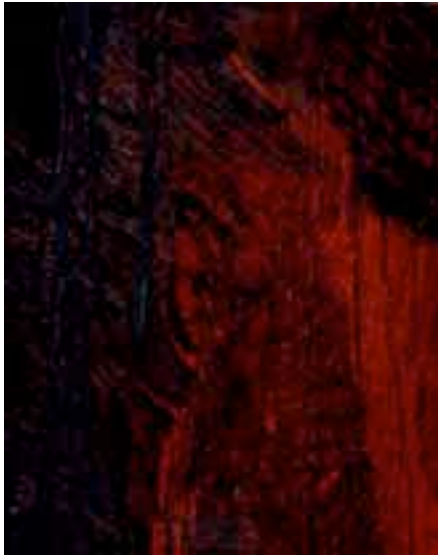
From 1981-1984 I had a job in the Sultanate of Oman; working with women weavers. I travelled onto the Red Sea Hills in Sudan after my three years in Oman, just at the beginning of the dreadful 1984 famine. On my return to UK I re-established myself as self employed artist. I was infused with the landscape of Oman; especially the extraordinary rock structures and mountains. These demanded a different material than fibre, something dry and crisp. I started to make my own paper pulp using various plant materials, often using the materials I used to weave with. I dyed the pulp in the way I used to dye fibres for weaving.

Size: 155cm high x 180cm wide



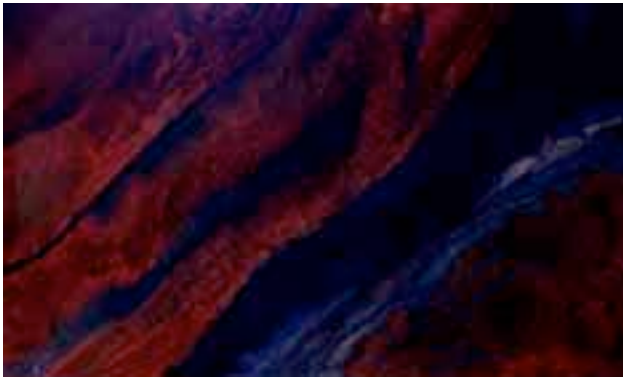
Slipping Memories

Size: 100cm high x 95cm wide



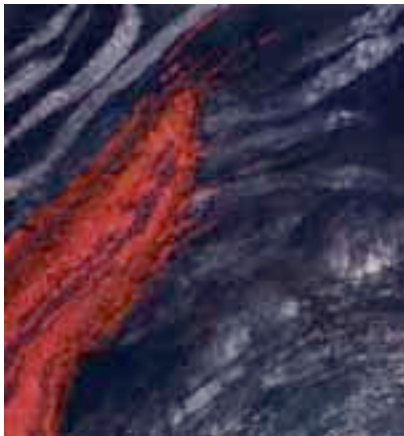
Dying Landscape
